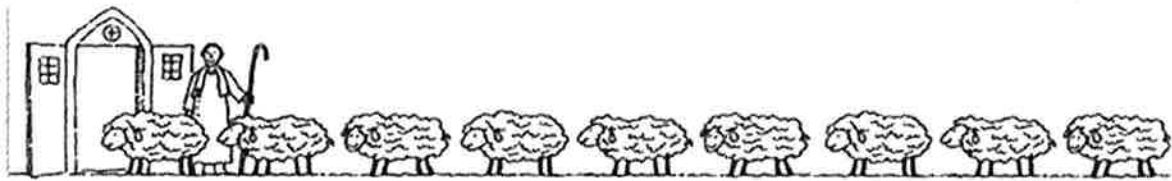

**Adult Lectionary Bible Study** *Library*

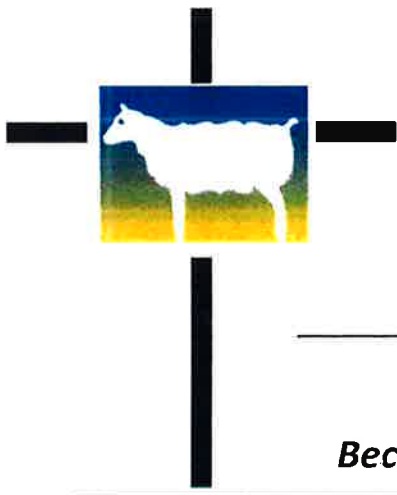
Discuss & Study the upcoming Sunday lectionary readings.
