

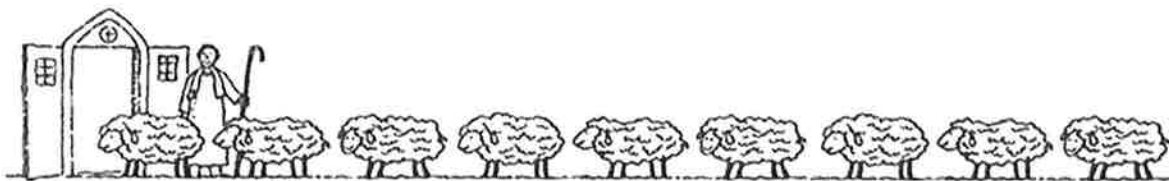

We challenge you to sleep somewhere besides your own bed  
on Saturday night, Sept. 22,  
all while raising money for this wonderful program.

### **Here is how it will work:**

- Sign up to sleep either at Holy Shepherd with many of your “close” friends OR if you plan to sleep at your home either on a couch, a different bed or even on the opposite side of the bed that you usually sleep on.
- Ask for donations from others to support you on this fundraiser. Funds will be collected on Sunday, September 23.
- The Kick-off to this event will be Saturday, Sept. 22 at 6:30pm. We will gather at Holy Shepherd in the Fellowship Hall for a “food bank dinner” followed by a movie and popcorn. If you plan to sleep over at the church, you will stay and “make camp” otherwise you will go to your own home for a different sleeping experience. *(If you are unable to attend the Kick-Off you can still sign up and participate in the sleeping experience, wherever that may be)*
- We will gather again on Sunday morning, Sept. 23, at 8:00 to help prepare a breakfast for the Holy Shepherd community.
- Breakfast will be served, between services, to all who want to attend for a donation to this program.

If you are unable to participate in the sleeping part,  
you are welcome to make a donation to those who are participating  
and/or attend the breakfast for a donation.

## *Family Promise Facts*

- Did you know there are only 26 affordable units for every 100 extremely low income families in Colorado?
- There are several factors that lead families to experience homelessness, but the #1 factor in 2017 was the lack of affordable housing.
- This is why we need your help! Won't you join us in raising funds for the Family Promise Home Program?
- We know that the critical time to stabilize a family is immediately after they gain housing. The Home Program allows families to step out of the trauma of homelessness and focuses on keeping them employed and stably housed.
- In 2017, 28 families were served in Home. 86% of these families were employed and 96% were stably housed at the end of the year.
- Holy Shepherd has a long tradition of helping Family Promise. It takes as many as 400 volunteer hours to provide one week for the families we host here with Christ on the Mountain Catholic Church.
- In 2016, Arvada United Methodist Church began hosting a second week in the west rotation at Holy Shepherd. It is a treat for the families to be able to stay at one church for two weeks!
- Now we are ready to have some **fun** fundraising for the Home Program.
