## Safety & Security Team Report

In early September, three representatives of the Safety and Security Team and Pete Morse (chair of the Property Team) met with David Allen, West Metro Fire Marshall's Office, for a complete Fire Safety Inspection of Holy Shepherd Lutheran Church and Office building. The Fire Marshall found our Church to be generally in Fire Code compliance but identified eight issues where our church failed the inspection. Subsequently, led by Pete Morse, Gerry Scholten, Jim Freeman, and Mary Biefel, those issues have all been addressed and our Church is now in compliance with West Metro Fire Codes.

On September 10 the Congregation voted to approve the contract with Excel Mechanical to replace the 35 ton HVAC unit.

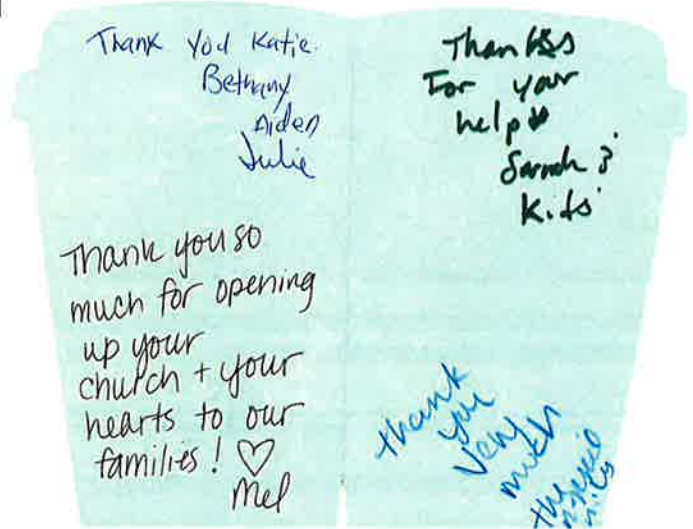
We have signed a bid for \$73,000. The installation is expected to begin November 27.

### Thoughts from Bishop Jim:

Our Spirit-empowered call as Christ's Church is to bear witness to the Gospel in various contexts, reflecting on the needs and realities of each particular time and place we are sent. As the ELCA Rocky Mountain Synod, we support and promote ministries intentionally committed to engaging changing contexts, emerging communities and neighbors on the margins. Together we are proclaiming God's unconditional love for the sake of the world in new places and in new ways.

### Mission Moment: *Redvelopment: St. Matthew's, Taylorsville, UT*

People often ask what does it take to undergo redevelopment? At St. Matthew's, we feel that establishing a team of people who are dedicated to *seeing it through* is essential. Our Redevelopment Ministry Team has met nearly every single week since February 2016! The team spends time in deep discernment through bible study, prayer, listening and in conversation with each other, the congregation and our neighbors. As a result, this process has transformed the congregational leadership, built new ministry teams and leaders, identified the congregation's core values and missional purpose. The Redevelopment of St. Matthew's is well on its way to stability and sustainability.
