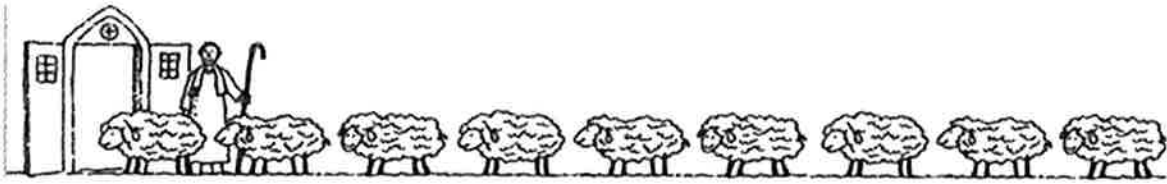

- **Day Light Savings Time ends next weekend** - Please remember to set your clocks back one hour next Saturday night before you go to bed.

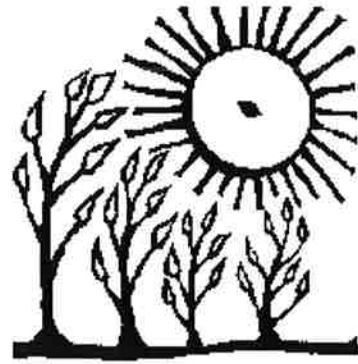
