

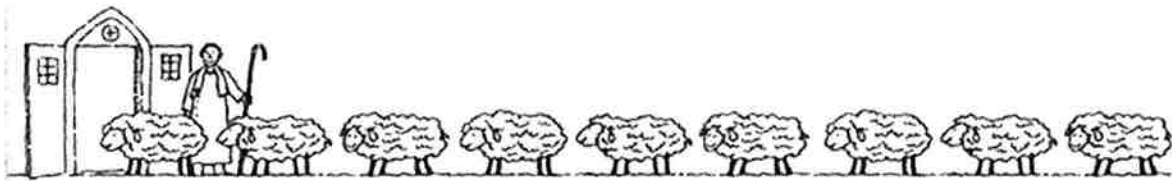

2018 Summer Liturgy

We gather for worship this summer at Holy Shepherd, with a theme

Bread for the Journey:

Taken, Blessed, Broken, Given

We have chosen this theme because we are in an interim time in the life of the congregation; *a time to reflect, a time for self-study, a time to listen to God and a time to ready ourselves for God's future.*

It is journey time and we trust God's Bread will sustain us!

We have planned a worship liturgy that uses the common pattern of the whole church for worship
– Gathering, Word, Meal & Sending.

Worship unites the people of God in one time and place with the people of God in every time and place. This common pattern for worship underscores our understanding of what it means to be the church, a people "called out" to do God's work in the world.

This summer liturgy focuses on the core of who we are and what we are sent to do. We are a people called and gathered by the Holy Spirit around Jesus Christ who is present in Word and the sacraments and sends us out as witnesses.

This common and simplified liturgy will be the basis for worship at 5:30 on Saturday evenings, 8:00 am and 10:45 am on Sunday mornings. Music will be provided by the organ and worship teams and various soloists who will bring their gifts.

We hope that this simple liturgy will give us common ground and inspiration as we journey in Christ's love. Peace be with you!
