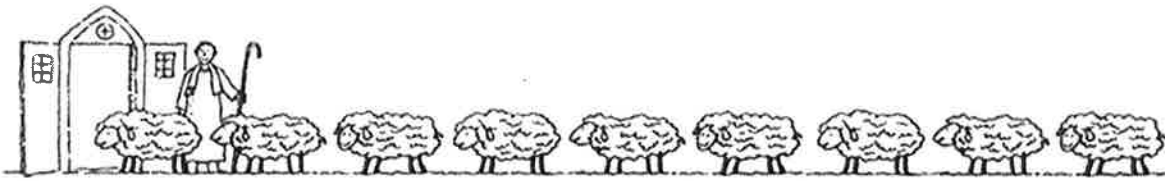

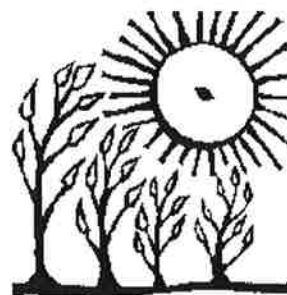
Year End Business

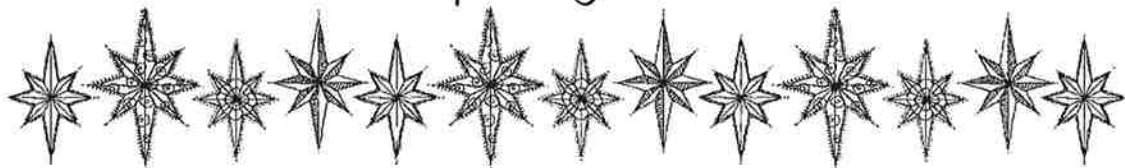
