Lutheran Disaster Response – US Tornadoes

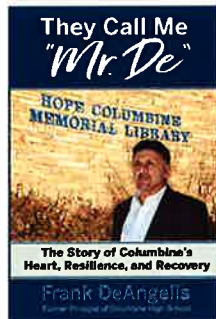
