

As groups consider meeting outdoors at the HSLC building, the Re-Gathering Team and Council ask that all groups carefully follow these requirements to prevent unintentional spread of Covid-19:

- Groups can be no larger than 15 people.
- All groups must gather outside—there will be no access to the buildings, including restrooms.
- There will only be one group gathering at HSLC at any given time.
- All those in attendance must wear a facemask at all times, unless eating.
- Physical distancing at a minimum of 6 feet must be maintained at all times.
- Each individual must bring their own chair.
- Any food or beverages must be brought by the individual. No group sharing of food (i.e.: a communal grill or box of doughnuts).

***If you are a group leader and would like your group to meet on the grounds of HSLC, we ask that you do the following:***

- Contact the Church Office to make a reservation for your group's meeting time (office@holyshepherd.com).
- Create a reservation list of no more than 15 people, and e-mail this list to the office at least 24 hours in advance of your meeting. (This is important for contact tracing should someone become sick).
- Do not share materials, papers, pens, bulletins, etc. Please ask people to bring their own.
- Insure that the entire group follows the guidelines put forth by the HSLC Re-Gathering Team and the Church Council.
- Insure that all those in attendance know these rules and guidelines prior to attending an event.
- The day before the gathering check in with all planning to attend and ask the following questions. Anyone answering "yes" to these questions, should not attend:
  - Have you been in contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19?
  - Do you have a fever over 100° F?
  - Do you have new onset of cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, sore throat, muscle aches, chills, loss of taste/smell, vomiting, diarrhea, or severe headache?
- Assume that vulnerable or immune-compromised individuals will be present and act to ensure their safety throughout the gathering.

We look forward to the joy that comes as we gather together again. We look forward to hearing stories about what you're learning and how you are growing together. We remain grateful for your patience and willingness to adjust these past several months. The Holy Spirit continues to be at work in each of us.
