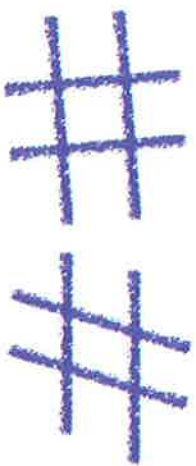
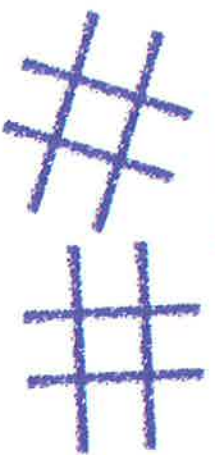
One way God reminded the people to remember only God was by giving them the Ten Commandments. Here's Moses with those commandments.
