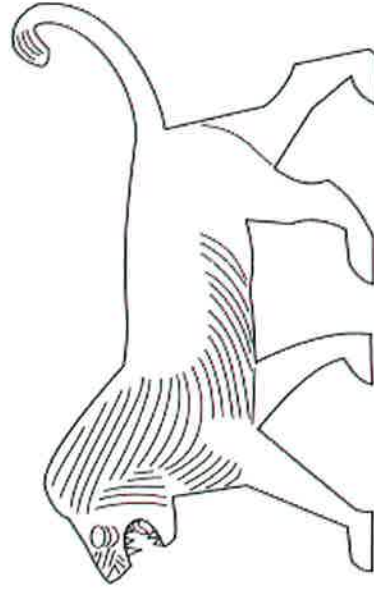
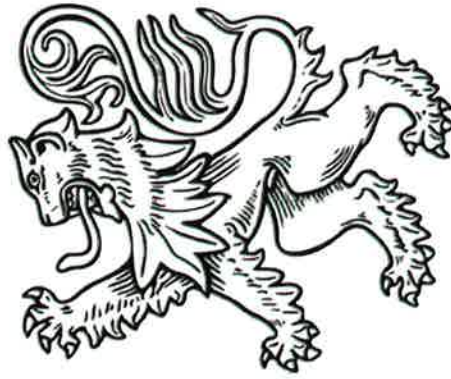

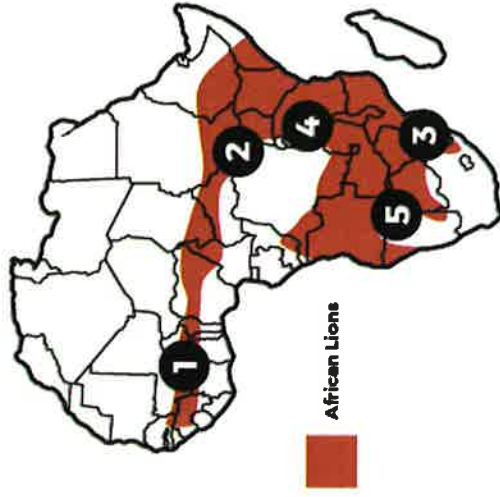

Sub-species include:

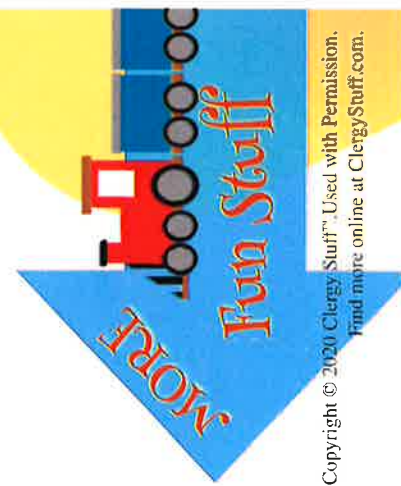
1. West African lion
