Look at the haul of fish they brought in! Wow! Color this picture and imagine how heavy a net full of fish would be.



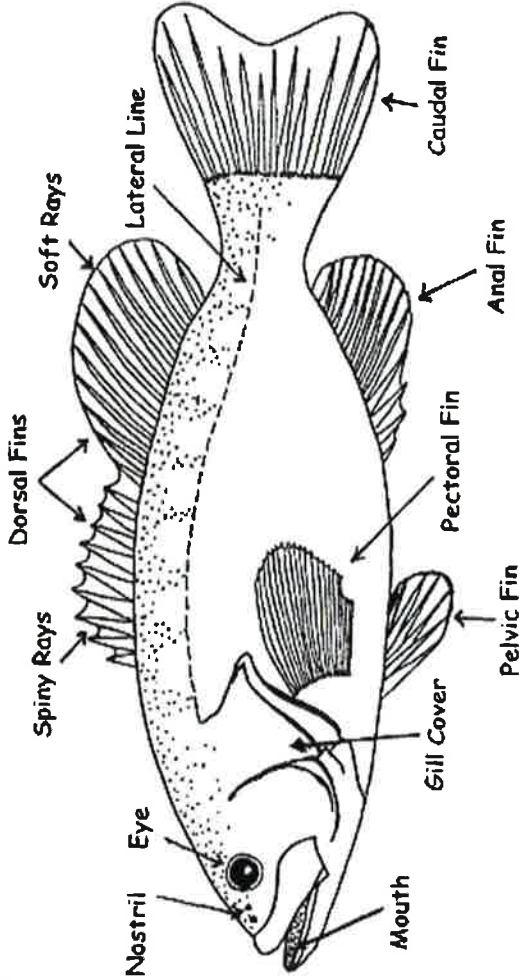

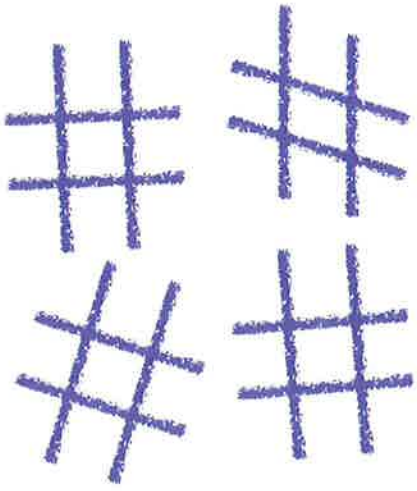

Go online with an adult and search for videos of people who fish for a living. Some catch fish with nets, others with hook, line, and sinker.

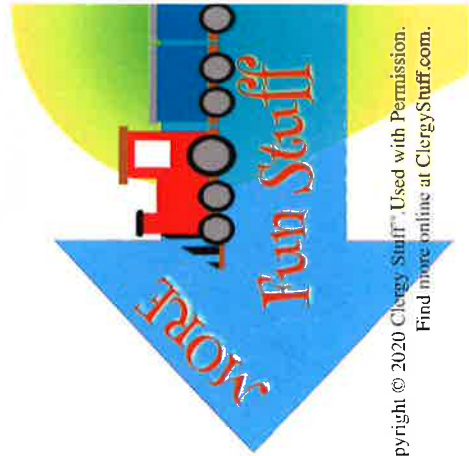
