Good Samaritan



Luke 10:25-42

Color the picture of the Samaritan helping the hurt man.



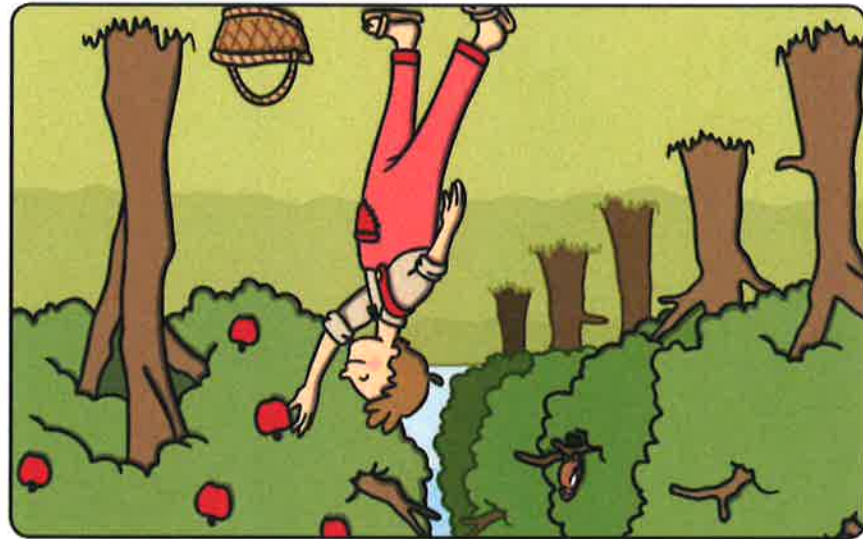

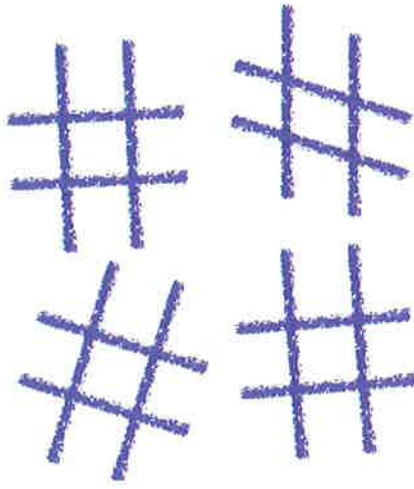


Spot the Differences

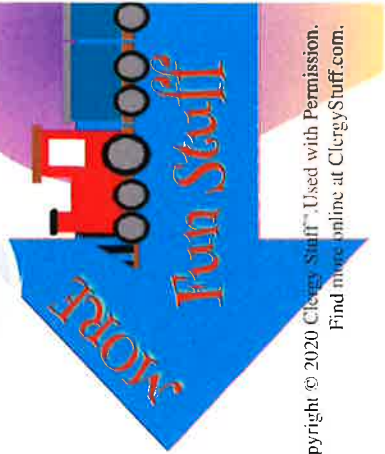
