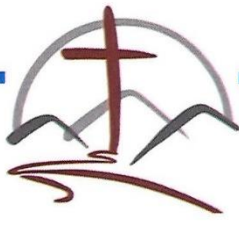

The Mission Team will collect your donations in the parking lot on **Sunday, March 21st 11 am to 1 pm.**



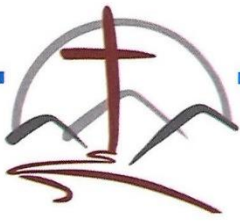
