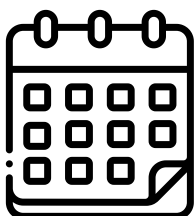

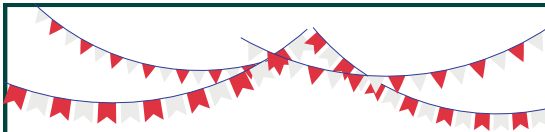

March Council Minutes Summary

Kevin Klinkerfues gave a great report on kitchen remodel plans (financed through the building fund), work on which will take place primarily in July. A committee was assigned the task of determining a recipient ministry for the tithe of the building fund donation, to be reported to the council in April. Another committee was assigned to study the ministry to younger families, to be reported on in two or three months. Scott reported that donations were down the first two months of the year and expenses up, but this was normal and to be expected. Melina Powelson has volunteered to fill the vacant personnel position on the board as a non-voting member. Upcoming social activities include the Easter breakfast and egg hunt, a May adult lunch, and the 70th anniversary of the congregation on June 22nd. A traveling Day Camp will take place June 23rd - June 27th from 9 to noon for younger children and afternoons for the older kids.
